

Actually, no shepherd would leave 99 sheep to go find one lost sheep.


The woman probably spent more money on the party than the coin was worth.



Wouldn't you be?



Which kinds of sheep are best for shepherds? They all are! Which kinds of people are best for God? We ALL are!


