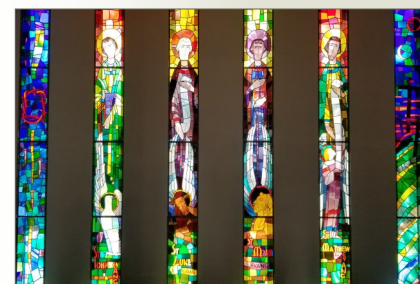

Our Commitment

Westworth United Church is open to people of all sexual orientation, gender identities and diverse cultural and faith backgrounds who seek support in dealing with the death of loved ones. Empowered by its faith in the promise of resurrection, the Church confronts the reality of death, consoles the bereaved, and offers thanks to God for the life of the deceased. These notes of grief, hope and thanksgiving sound forth in a Christian funeral service.

Minister

The minister works closely with you in arranging all the details of the service. This includes the date and time, order of service, choice of hymns and the participation of others who might be involved like musicians, clergy and laity.

Remains

As per United Church tradition, the coffin is closed for the service. If the deceased is cremated, we encourage you to have the ashes present for the service so that they may be blessed and commended into God's keeping. Please discuss these arrangements with the minister.

Music

An organ and a piano is available for services and our church organist provides the music. Once you have spoken with the minister, you are invited to discuss details of the service music with the organist. You may arrange to have a soloist or ask the organist to arrange a soloist.

In exceptional circumstances, a request for a different organist of your choosing might be made. In this event, permission from our church organist will have to be given. If your choice of organist plays instead, fees to our church organist will still have to be paid.

Flowers

Flowers may be delivered to the church. Please call the church office to arrange a convenient time for delivery. When selecting flowers, please note that due to allergy concerns you are asked to avoid lilies and other heavily scented florals.

Bulletins

Bulletins are provided complimentary by the church should you wish to include them with your service.

If you are having a reception at the end of the service, the following church areas are available.
