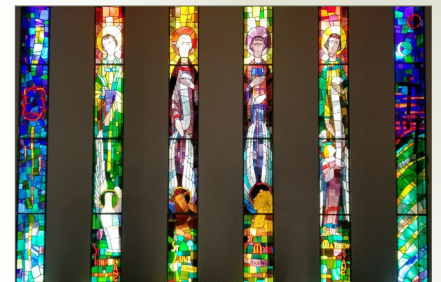

Our Commitment

At Westworth United, we commit to offering support to people of all sexual orientations, gender identities, cultural and church connection, as they process the grief of losing a loved one. With faith in the presence of God in life and death, the church confronts the reality of death, offers support and comfort to the grieving and offers thanks to God for the life of the deceased. This reality, hope and gratitude are integral to a Christian funeral/celebration of life.

Minister

The minister works closely with you in planning and arranging the details of the service. This includes date and time, order of service, choice of hymns, music and scripture; and the participation of others in the service, such as eulogists, musicians or others.

Remains

When a casket is present, it will remain closed for the duration of the service. If cremation has taken place, we encourage having the ashes present for the service, along with a picture of the person. The minister will ask for your preferences.

Music

An organ and a piano is available for services and our church musician provides the music. Once you have decided on music with the minister, they will communicate with the musician. You may arrange to have a soloist or ask to arrange a soloist. In exceptional circumstances, a request for a different musician of your choosing might be made. In this event, permission from our church musician will have to be given. Once you've decided on music with the minister, they will communicate with the musician.

Flowers

Flowers may be delivered to the church. Please call the church office to arrange a convenient time for delivery. When selecting flowers, please note that due to allergy concerns you are asked to avoid lilies and other heavily scented florals.

Bulletins

Bulletins are provided complimentary by the church should you wish to include them with your service.
